Race Briefing Script



Road Races – briefing to be provided to each start group

1. Chip registration check & roll call
2. Race instructions:
 - a. Number of laps
 - b. Location of feed zones
No feeding from moving vehicles.
 - c. Location of pit.
3. Course
 - a. Follow lead bike – no passing
 - b. Road open to traffic
 - c. No racing around moving vehicles on course
 - d. Notice of areas
4. Rules highlight
 - a. Centre line rule
 - i. If you do find your self across the yellow line – be sure not to advance ahead of other riders
 - ii. At sprint finish – full width of road or not
 - b. No working with riders of other categories or lapped riders
 - c. You may be pulled if you are lapped and will be deemed to have finished.
5. Juniors – reminder to report to roll out directly after race

Race Briefing Script

Criteria – briefing to be provided at each start

1. Chip registration check & roll call
2. Race instructions:
 - a. Time limit for race
 - b. Full width of road – look out for parked cars / pedestrians
 - c. No feeding zones / external assistance except in pit
 - d. Location of pit
 - i. Must report to pit judge
 - e. TIME BONUSES, if there are any - listen for the BELL
3. Course
 - a. Identify any special concerns on course
4. Rule review
 - a. LAP OUT RULE review
 - i. Genuine mechanical
 - ii. Must report to pit judge
 - iii. No lap out after leader starts last 5 laps of race
 - b. Lapped riders
 - i. AFTER MECHANICAL - will be put in where they left the race or at the rear of the group
 - ii. May not lead riders ahead or about to pass
 - iii. May not participate in time bonus within 1 lap of return
 - iv. May be pulled if appropriate and will be considered to have finished
5. Juniors – reminder to report to roll out directly after race
